Halacha of the Week	It is forbidden to perform an act on Shabbos solely as a preparation for after Shabbos, even if the act in question does not involve Melacha, under the prohibition known as "Hachana". Nevertheless, an act which is performed both for Shabbos benefit as well as after Shabbos benefit is permitted. Examples are: clearing off a dirty table if the messy appearance is disturbing; making beds to tidy up a room, even if the beds won't be used again until after Shabbos; resting on Shabbos afternoon even if one is catching up on sleep for the following week.
