Youth@YISI Rules and Regulations

The safety and security is of the utmost importance to us at the YISI Youth Department. Please note the following rules and regulations that are in place to ensure that Youth@YISI groups and programming are a safe, welcome and happy place.

- 1. During Shul on Shabbat morning all children, grades N-8 must either be in shul with their parents or at groups. No children may be wandering the halls at this time.
- 2. Children may only be dropped off at morning groups if their parent/guardian is davening in the Young Israel at the time of groups.
- 3. Pickup from groups
 - Morning groups are over as soon as the minyan you are davening in is completed. Please make sure to pick up your child(ren) before attending any kiddush you may be invited to following davening.
 - b. Afternoon groups are from 2:30-4:00 pm. Parents who are picking up children/hosting house groups must be at the shul ON TIME. Every parent is responsible for making sure that their child's house group host family is aware that groups is by their house and that they must be at the shul by 4:00 pm.
 - c. No child under the age of 12 will be allowed to leave groups on their own. A responsible adult must come for pick up.
- 4. Children at groups must be respectful of the other children and counselors as well as the Young Israel property.
- All children must have a youth information form filled out in order to attend groups and youth department activities. Forms can be filled out online at <u>http://tinyurl.com/YISIYOUTH17</u>. A paper copy is also attached to this packet.
