Halacha of the Week	A person should add time to Shabbos, both at its onset and conclusion. This extra time is known as Tosofos Shabbos. According to many Rishonim and the Mechaber, adding time is a mitzvas aseh m'doraisa but does not carry the penalties of Kares or Chatas. The time should be added before the onset of Bein Hashemashos at the onset of Shabbos and after Bein Hashemashos at the conclusion of Shabbos. Adding time at the beginning of Shabbos is done by verbally accepting Shabbos prior to the official time or by responding to Barechu of the evening prayer.
