Halacha of the Week	There is a Mitzvah upon every household to light candles before Shabbos. Special preference and responsibility for this mitzvah has been given to women, as women usually are the caretakers of the home. The husband may take part in several ways; a) by pre-lighting and quickly extinguishing the candles, thereby making them easier to light, b) the first shabbos after his wife gives birth the husband should light the candles (and make the bracha), and c) if additional candles will be lit in other rooms of the house, this may be done by the husband.
