Halacha of the Week	There is a dispute which Adar is the real thing, Adar I or Adar II? Most are of the opinion if the passing of a loved one occurred during a year with only one Adar, that in a year when there are two Adars, the yearzeit is observed in Adar I. The reason is that an observance of a yearzeit is to give honor, Kavod, to the one that passed. Therefore, we do it early, as not to procrastinate. However, it is commendable to also say kaddish on the day of the month in Adar II.
