Halacha of the Week	The halachah is that the times of chatzos – midday and midnight – change from day to day, though according to the Iggros Moshe it occurs at a fixed time of the day.  Based on the standard method of calculation, midday (chatzos ha-yom) is the time when the sun is directly above our heads, which is the halfway point between sunrise and sunset. The general custom is to use the equivalent time for midnight (twelve hours from midday), and this is the time that generally appears in calendars.  Some are stringent for purposes of Torah law (such as eating matzah on Pesach) to calculate the time of midnight (chatzos ha-laila) as the midpoint between nightfall (tzeis ha-kochavim) and daybreak (alos), a far earlier time than the equivalent of midday.
