Halacha of the Week	I always daven ma'ariv at the 10 o'clock minyan. Am I permitted to wash and eat a meal when I get home from work at 9 o'clock (after tzeis hakochavim) or should I count sefira first? Igros Moshe writes that the proper time to count sefira is after ma'ariv. One should not count sefira before ma'ariv, because of the rule "tadir kodem" (the mitzvah that is more frequent should be done first). Since ma'ariv is recited every night of the year, and sefira is only recited between Pesach and Shavuos, one should daven ma'ariv before counting sefira. An individual who relies on the fact that he always davens at a set minyan so as to eat before ma'ariv, may rely on this as well regarding sefiras HaOmer. Rav Moshe argues that in this case, since he has a set minyan where he always davens, it is better for him to recite sefira before the meal, which would be out of order. Nonetheless, if one is afraid that they might forget to count sefira if they wait until after ma'ariv, they may count before ma'ariv as well.
