Halacha of the Week	Not only does a Sukkah have special holiness, but the decorations are infused with holiness as well. One may not remove Sukkah decorations from a Sukkah for no reason, unless they were hung before Sukkos on condition that they should not become holy. However, if one is concerned that they will be ruined or stolen, they may be removed. Similarly, if the intent is to hang them in another Sukkah, it is permitted to remove the decorations in order to move them. This is not considered “bizui mitzvah” (belittling of the mitzvah), since the decoration is being transferred to another Sukkah. If the decorations were hanging from the s’chach, they should be hung again on the s’chach, which has a higher level of holiness than the walls.
