Halacha of the Week

The Rambam writes that there is an obligation to answer Amen when hearing a bracha, even if one did not hear the entire bracha and even if he is not obligated to recite this bracha. However, the Beis Yosef believes the Tur to be saying that answering Amen to a bracha is optional. The Bach and others believe the Tur agrees with the Rambam. The Shulchan Aruch rules in accordance with the Rambam that if one hears a bracha, there is an obligation to answer Amen.

The Mishnah Berurah writes that the obligation to respond Amen to a bracha is based on the Biblical verse, When I call the name of Hashem, bestow greatness to our G-d (Devarim 32:3).

Reb Yossi states that answering Amen is a greater mitzvah than reciting the bracha (Brachos 53b), and the Talmud relates that the gates of Gan Eden are opened for those who answer Amen with all their strength (Shabbos 119b).
