Halacha of the Week	<p>When is the proper time to give the Zecher L'Machtzis Hashekel?</p> <p>The Gemara teaches us that the miraculous salvation of the Jewish people in the time of Purim was in the merit of the mitzvah of Machtzis Hashekel (the half shekel given each year for the communal sacrifices). Although we can no longer bring the sacrifices, as a remembrance for this mitzvah and the salvation, there is a custom to give a Zecher L'Machtzis Hashekel each year before we read about the evil decree of Haman. Maseches Sofrim writes that the coins should be given before reading Parshas Zachor. However, the Rama writes that this is no longer the custom. Instead, the Zecher L'Machtzis Hashekel should be given on Taanis Esther before davening Mincha. Some explain that we specifically give the Zecher L'Machtzis Hashekel before Purim and not on Purim so as not to confuse these coins with Matanos L'evyonim. It is customary to give the coins as close to Purim as possible.</p>
