Halacha of the Week	<p>One should not daven in front of paintings or pictures as these images can disturb a person's concentration. If disturbances arise, one should close his eyes when davening. It is forbidden to daven in front of a mirror even if a person closes his eyes, since it gives the impression that one is bowing to his own reflection. A person should be careful not to daven in front of a window at night, as the contrast between the indoor light and the night sky accentuates his reflection. Some shuls place a mirrored plaque with various pesukim engraved on it in front of the chazan. The poskim permit its placement since it is not meant as a mirror for reflection.</p>
