Halacha of the Week	If a person owns their home, they are obligated to put mezuzos on the door as soon as they occupy the home. If one moves furniture and other belongings into a house, but has not actually started living there, there is a dispute between poskim whether a mezuzah is required. Shulchan Aruch (YD 236:22) rules that if one rents a house or apartment in the Diaspora, the requirement to put up mezuzos begins after 30 days have elapsed – on the 31st day (the day of the move counts as day one, even if it is only a partial day). Others disagree and maintain that if the lease is for more than 30 days, the obligation to post mezuzos begins immediately. The Magen Avrohom suggests that it is permissible to put a mezuzah on the wall during the first thirty days and recite a bracha. By doing so, all opinions will be covered.
