Halacha of the Week	The focus on Teshuva is even more important than the fasting itself. Those who fast, but spend the day on trips or tours, have "grabbed onto the (aspect of) minor (significance) and left over the (aspect of) major (significance)". Five tragedies happened on Tisha B'Av; 1. The 1st Beis Hamikdash was destroyed; 2. The 2nd Beis Hamikdash was destroyed; 3. It was decreed that all the Jews in the Midbar would not enter Eretz Yisroel; 4. The city of Beitar was captured and thousands of Jews were murdered; 5. Turnisrufus Ha'Rasha plowed the Heichal and the Mokom Hamikdash.
