Halacha of the Week	<p>Q. Is one required to have two sets of saltshakers, one for dairy and one for meat?</p> <p>A. The Rema writes that there is a minhag is to have separate bowls of salt for milchig and for fleishig, because when one dips food into the salt, crumbs might remain behind. This concern does not seemingly apply to a saltshaker. The salt is well protected inside the shaker, and it is unlikely that any crumbs would fall through the tiny holes. Nevertheless, there is a widespread minhag to have separate shakers. Sefer Badei Hashulchan points out that if there are young children who might touch the saltshaker to their food, then it is certainly proper to have separate shakers. He applies this to other condiments that are brought to the table as well, such as ketchup and mustard. If there is concern that children might squeeze the bottles right against their food, it is best to designate them for meat or dairy.</p>
