Halacha of the Week	Nachem; The earliest reference to this Tisha B'Av insertion is in the Talmud Yerushalmi, and later in various medieval sources. Many early authorities favored its recital during all the Amida prayers of Tisha B'Av, but in due course it became the accepted practice to recite it only at Mincha. To understand this practice, R. Joseph B. Soloveitchik, following the Midrash Eikha, would point to the Gemara, which states that it was precisely on Tisha B'Av afternoon that the First Temple was set afire and continued to burn through the next day. Far from being a source of despair, this was in fact one of consolation and strength, for up to that point the fear was that God would destroy the people of Israel. When, however, they saw that the wood and stones of the Temple were bearing the brunt of His anger, and the people as a whole would be allowed to survive to be given a second chance, they were relieved and comforted. Hence nnn (consolation) is in order for us at Mincha time, and so we recite the paragraph then, and not before.
