Halacha of the Week	A person may eat meat immediately after dairy, provided the following three stipulations are met: 1) He must clean and rinse his mouth. 2) His hands must be clean. 3) A different tablecloth must be used, to make sure there is no residual food on it. It is forbidden to eat from the same loaf of bread during the meat and dairy parts of the meal, also to ensure that no residual food is on it. There are those who are careful to wait for half an hour between dairy and meat. Some will wait an hour, based on a passage in the Zohar. An exception to this would be eating hard cheese. In that case, one must wait the amount of time that he waits after eating meat before eating dairy. For many people this would be six hours.
