Halacha of the Week	Shulchon Aruch writes that a person should make an effort to daven in a beis hakneses together with a minyan of men. This ruling contains a twofold directive: 1) to daven with a minyan, since Hashem will never despise the tefilah of a tzibur, and 2) to daven in shul, as opposed to convening a minyan at home. Many poskim say that although Shulchon Aruch does not describe davening with a minyan as an absolute requirement, there is an obligation to do so. The primary component of tefila b'tzibur is davening Shemoneh Esrei together with ten men. One must begin Shemoneh Esrei with the tzibur. Some poskim say that as long as one starts while a member of the tzibur is davening, it counts as tefila b'tzibur. The poskim also disagree about whether there must be at least ten men who are davening or whether it is sufficient to have six daveners and four people who are not davening to complete a minyan.
