Halacha of the Week	It is proper to abstain from reciting the bracha of "Shehecheyanu" during the three weeks between the Seventeenth of Tammuz and the Ninth of Av on a new fruit or a new garment. One should leave the new fruit or garment for after Tisha B'Av rather than to eat the fruit or wear the garment without reciting "Shehecheyanu." On the Shabbatot that fall out during the "Three Weeks," one may recite "Shehecheyanu" on a new fruit or garment. Nevertheless, following Rosh Chodesh Av, it is preferable to abstain from reciting "Shehecheyanu" on a new garment, even on Shabbat. However, regarding eating a new fruit on the Shabbat following Rosh Chodesh Av, one may act leniently and do so, and recite "Shehecheyanu" (Yechave Da'at, Vol. 1, Ch. 37).
