Halacha of the Week	On a boat trip, one recites Tefilas Haderech on the first day when the boat leaves the city. However, Minchas Shlomo writes that there is a question as to whether one should recite Tefilas Haderech on the subsequent days. Ordinarily during a trip, one stops to go to sleep. This break requires one to recite a new bracha in the morning. However, a boat continues to travel day and night, even while the passengers are sleeping. It is questionable whether going to sleep on a boat constitutes an interruption. To get around this issue, one should incorporate Tefilas Haderech into Shmoneh Esrei in the bracha of Shema Koleinu, which also ends with the bracha of "Shomei'a Tefilla." If the boat docks in a port overnight, then one should recite the bracha of Tefilas Haderech in the morning.
